





## What is the IB Diploma Programme?

- Rigorous pre-university course of studies
- Designed as comprehensive two-year curriculum that allows its graduated to fulfill requirements of various national education systems
- Research suggests that there are many benefits to choosing the Diploma Programme (DP). The programme aims to develop students who have excellent breadth and depth of knowledge – students who flourish physically, intellectually, emotionally and ethically.



#### What courses do IB students take?

IB Diploma students must select courses in a specific manner prescribed by IB:

- Will take 6 courses
- One from each subject "group": 3 of these courses at a Higher Level (HL) and 3 of these at Standard Level (SL) and they will engage with the Core elements of TOK, CAS and the EE
- G12 71% IBDP students
- G11 83% IBDP students

## LAS Diploma with IB Courses Scoring



Score of 5 or higher in IB English A waives IELTS/TOEFL

Score of 7 IB English B also may waive IELTS/TOEFL

Allow for advanced placement at various universities

# LAS Diploma - English Language Acquisition

- Allows flexibility in a particular subject(s)
- Student-focused special talent or hobby
- Earn a US high school diploma credential coupled with standardized tests (SAT, ACT or SAT subject exams - recognized worldwide)
- Focus: academic strengths, self-reflection, leadership, and relationships
- Highly individualized academic plan
- G12 29% of students
- G11 17% of students

- Choosing the correct program based on a students ability and potential is of the highest importance
- LAS faculty, deans and university advisors advise each student individually on his or her course selections
- Selection of courses based on academic performance, interests and requirements for entry into top universities of student's choice


