Responsibilities:

- 1. Provides health care and assistance to sick and injured students and staff.
- 2. Collaborates with all support staff to maintain a hygienic and clean environment
- 3. Works as a supportive, integral member of LAS Summer staff team
- 4. Contributes to LAS Summer Orientation and leads a 'healthcare' session
- 5. Arranges clinic visits when necessary and provides transportation to the clinic in town or local clinics/hospitals.
- 6. Maintains a log of all student visits to the health center
- 7. Contacts parents and/or educational agents as necessary with updates on student health
- 8. Establishes effective communications channels with key staff
- 9. Ensures that all reports are completed within stated deadlines.
- 10. Share responsibility for the 24-hour phone line (the nurse on call or NOC phone)
- 11. Adheres to all LAS Policy and Procedure as outlined in the Staff Handbook
- 12. Ensures that all reports are completed within stated deadlines.
- 13. Carries out any other duty as assigned by the LAS Summer Director.
