

General booking conditions:

Payment - Cancellation:

Acceptance to LAS summer constitutes a contract to pay the entire tuition for the enrolled period. A deposit of CHF 2,000 must accompany the application form. The remaining balance is due no later than May 15, 2018. For applications received after May 15, 2018 full payment is required with the application. There is no reduction or refund for absence, withdrawal, or dismissal. In the event of a cancellation, the deposit of (CHF 1,500) is non-refundable. Fees, except for the enrollment deposit, are refundable only upon written request prior to May 01, 2018. There will be no refund for late arrivals or early departures.

Fees Include:

Fees cover full room and board, regular instruction, use of computers, loan of required books, excursions, activities, accident/health liability insurance coverage (see conditions in Student Information Handbook), and transfer to and from Geneva Airport on specified travel days. Fees do not cover transfers to and from Geneva Airport on any day other than specified travel days, transfer to and from any other city, pocket money, optional activities, dry cleaning, and similar expenses of a personal nature.

Medical:

I have completed the Health section of the Application Form accurately. I hereby give permission for emergency medical and surgical treatments for my son/daughter as may be considered necessary by the medical staff of LAS summer and the attending physician(s). I hereby attest that all information listed on this form is true and understand that LAS summer reserves the right to dismiss any student if the information is false or misleading.

Excursions:

During some excursions, students can be given up to three hours free time before mandatory check-in with staff. All students stay in groups of at least two and are encouraged to carry personal cell phones.

Programs:

In the event a class has been oversubscribed LAS summer will open a waiting list. Applications are processed on a first come first served basis. In the case of insufficient numbers to run the class LAS summer will offer a change of program at no extra cost. LAS summer reserves the right to modify or make changes to the program listed on its website for any reason beyond its control.

LAS Summer Code of Behavior and Liability:

At all times, students at LAS summer:

- Respect the cultural and social differences of their student peers and adult mentors
- Respect the property of the school, the property of the local sport centers and businesses in Leysin, and the property of the sites visited on excursions
- Respect the rules and norms of behavior in Switzerland, including quiet behavior between the hours of 22.00-08.00.

At no times do students at LAS summer:

- Use tobacco products, including cigarettes, chewing tobacco, and snuff; a student found smoking may be given a drug test.
- Use alcohol; a student found drinking will be sent home.
- Use illegal drugs, including marijuana; a student using drugs will be sent home.
- Threaten another participant, whether student or staff, with physical or verbal violence and abuse. The student will be sent home.

Failure to adhere to the LAS summer Code of Behavior will result in punishment, up to and including immediate dismissal from the program at the cost of the student and his or her family.

An unsatisfactory discipline record from the previous summer may result in non-acceptance for a future summer.

Leysin American School reserves the right to dismiss a student at any time if that student has proven to be an unsatisfactory member of the school community even though there may have been no infraction of a specific rule. In this case, LAS summer retains the entire payment. Additional costs related to dismissal from the program, E.G. Fees incurred for changing plane tickets and transport to the airport, are the responsibility of the parent / guardian. False or incomplete information may also result in LAS summer reserving the right to dismiss a student with no refund.
